Selection criteria

- 1. Maximum 10 Applications will be selected whose proposed pilots will be implemented during May to December 2020. Selection is based on the results of the evaluation described in clause 3.
- 2. The selection between Applicants shall be done by the Organizer's competition committee, which consist of at least 5 experts (representatives of European grid operators and technical experts of data exchange).
- 3. The committee will consider how well the Application presents the following aspects in the proposed pilot in a 5 point scale with "1" being poorly demonstrated to "5" being very well demonstrated:
 - 3.1 Market integration pilots who want to enter new European markets or involve partners from more than two (2) countries are preferred. However, the high number of partners should not challenge the implementation of the pilot.
 - 3.2 Increase of competition and services in the area of flexibility, efficiency, retail or other innovative area of energy services.
 - 3.3 Empowerment of the consumer in the energy market by enabling the consumers to participate in the energy market and giving the consumer more control of its private data and services.
 - 3.4 Relevance of the pilot for other market participants.
 - 3.5 Solving of important market barriers.
 - 3.6 Successful implementation in 3-6 months' time and by the end of 2020 it is evaluated if the pilot and its implementation has been thought through in a sufficient way and it is doable in terms of time, resources and partners available.
